

The HTIR Work-Study program is designed to help applicants gain the skills necessary to become competitive professionals in their fields.

In the HTIR Work-Study program, the schools are allowed to issue work permits for full-time off-campus employment in US based companies, where students can earn US wages, from the beginning of the student's studies.

Unlike other work-study programs in the United States, HTIR students are NOT required to wait a full academic year before working.

Coleman University provides the academic coursework as well as the training for successful employment to those enrolled in the co-op program. Various workforce skills are taught, including resume building, interview procedures, and legal and cultural aspects of the workplace. These courses, which are taught during the first three months of the work-study program, are designed to help students obtain and maintain their job internship position.

HTIR, an American firm owned and operated by a US lawyer, assists the program in matters pertaining to CPT employment, and handles all questions and inquires about the co-op programs. HTIR receives all initial co-op applications and student documents required for application to the Cooperative Education program at Coleman University.

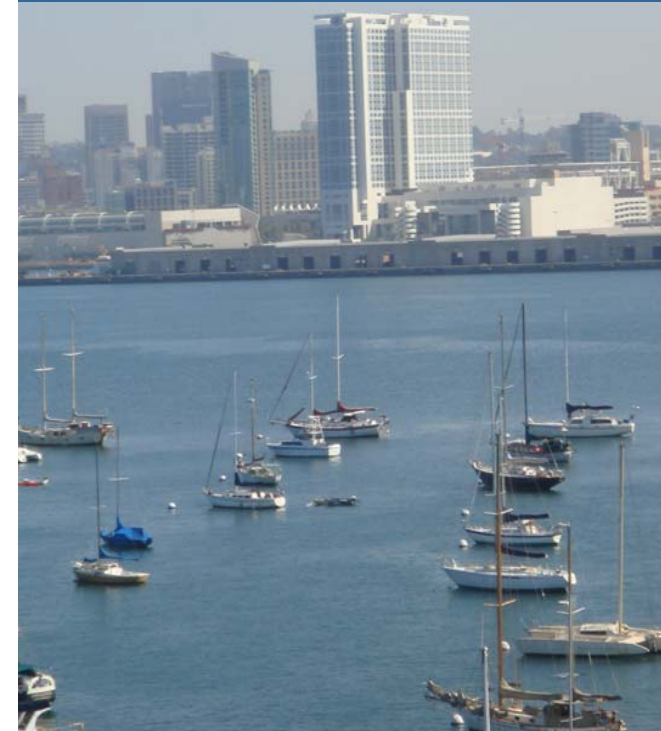

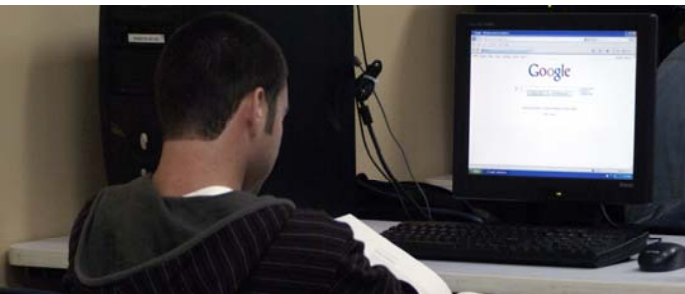
Coleman University is a nationally accredited, private university located in San Diego, California.
