

THE HTIR WORK-STUDY PROGRAM

The HTIR Work-Study program is designed to help applicants gain the skills necessary to become competitive professionals in their fields.

In the HTIR Work-Study program, the schools are allowed to issue work permits for full-time off-campus employment in US based companies, where students can earn US wages, from the beginning of the student's studies.

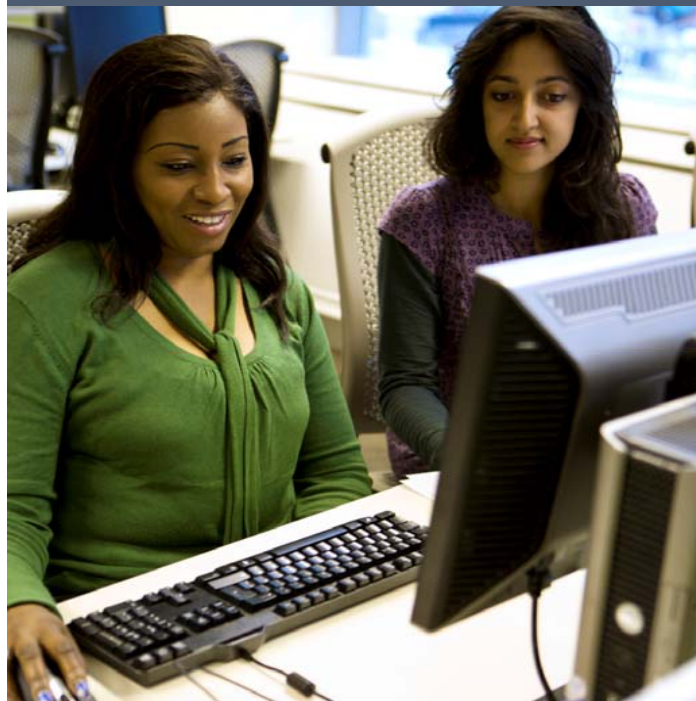
Unlike other CPT programs in the United States, HTIR students are NOT required to wait a full academic year before working.

HTIR delivers an employment and cultural workshop which provides training for successful employment to those enrolled in the work-study program. Various workforce skills are taught, including resume building, interviewing procedures, and legal and cultural aspects of the workplace. The workshop, which is taught during the first three months of the co-op program, is designed to help students obtain and maintain their internship position.

HTIR handles all questions and inquiries, and receives all applications and student documents required for application to the Work-Study program at Lincoln University.

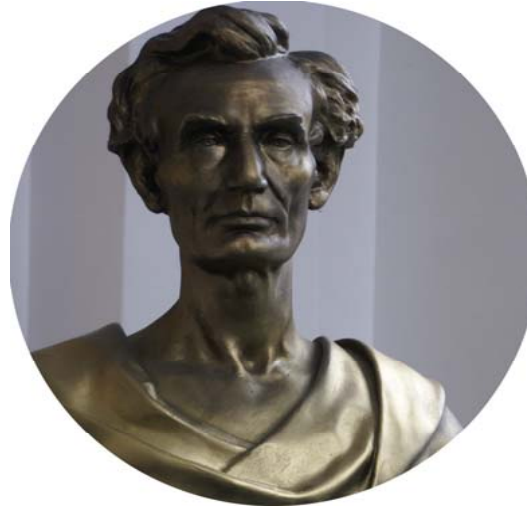
HTIRWORK-STUDY PROGRAM

Lincoln University, which is nationally accredited, was founded in 1919 and is a private, non-profit, non-sectarian educational institution. Since its beginning, Lincoln University has maintained an interracial and intercultural orientation. Lincoln was among the first post-secondary education schools to offer programs with a focus on the needs of working adults.

The MBA at Lincoln University is a professional degree. It is designed to develop broad managerial competence to enable graduates to cope with a wide variety of business situations appropriate to their diverse backgrounds. The Lincoln MBA program upholds a strong international focus. In order to fulfill the overall objective, emphasis is placed throughout the program on the development of the individual through the concentration on basic disciplines and skills, as well as specific subject areas.

HTIR, in alliance with Lincoln University, offers a unique practical training program which allows international students to work in full-time employment in local US based companies, while studying for their master degree. Students attend classes in the evenings or weekends and work in US companies, earning US wages during the day. This kind of program is known as a work-study or internship program and is available in Master of Business Administration.
